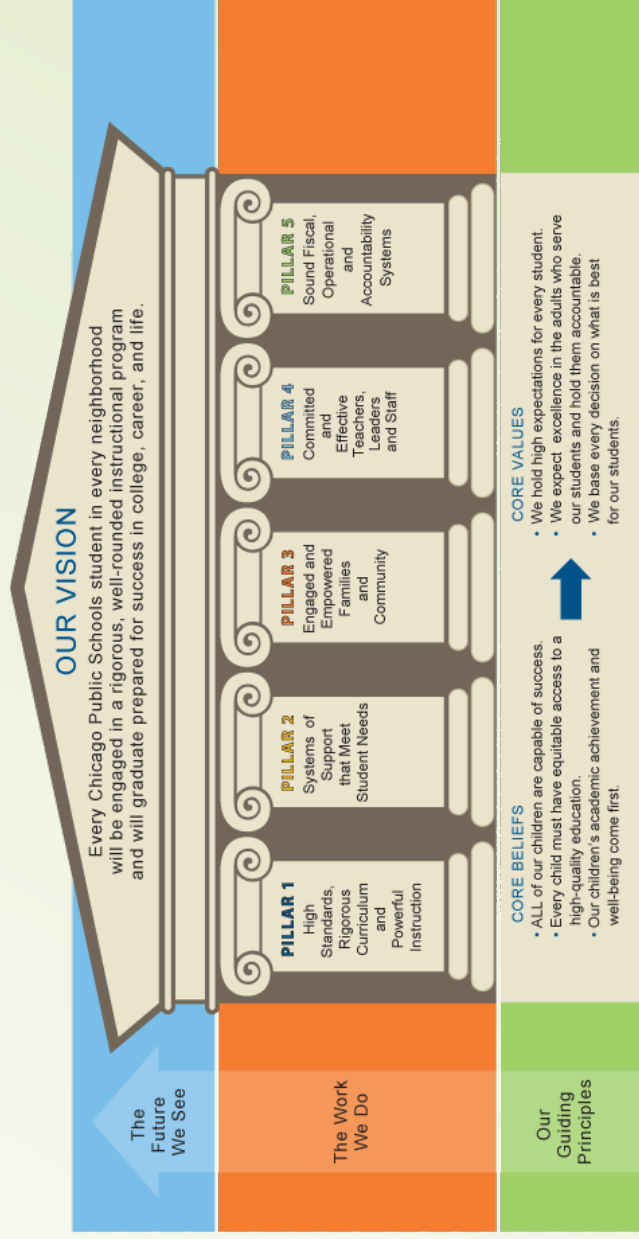

Beaubien Teams and Accomplishments

- Instructional Leadership Team(ILT)- Teacher leaders drive the implementation of strategies based on school data to increase the rigor of curriculum and instructional across all grade levels.
- Literacy and Math Teacher Leaders-Teacher leaders attend Network 1 Professional Development and present back to Beaubien Staff. Focus this year is English Language Learners
- Writing Committee-CIWP Priority #1-Continuation of analysis of current writing practices across all grade levels.
- Math Committee-CIWP Priority #2-Analysis of new math programs. Implemented new program Envision 2.0 for Kindergarten-5th Grade. Continues to evaluate programs for 6th-8th grade for 16/17 school year.
- Multi Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS)-Development of a formal committee to analyze students who are at risk and in need of a targeted intervention.
- Recognizing Educators Advancing Chicago's Students (REACH)-Teacher Performance Evaluation. Principal and Assistant Principal engage with teachers to advance teacher practice and student learning.

Beaubien Teams and Accomplishments

- DePaul Math Partnership-Continuation of Professional Development for both teachers and administrators
- Grade Level Teams (GLT)-Each grade levels meet and take minutes one a week to analyze current needs of the students as well as analyzing student work.
- After School Programs-Beaubien provides academic as well as clubs/sports for students to participate in. Right At School is an resource to families who are in need of after school care for their child.
- PTO, LSC and BAC-Parent and community involvement with school wide initiatives.

Goals

- Increase the percent of students hitting growth targets on MAP/NWEA to drive instruction.
- Continue to analyze grade level PARCC results to drive instruction.
- Research and choose a CCSS aligned math curriculum for 6th-8th grade.
- Work on grade level team analysis of student writing samples.
- Continue to work on increasing attendance to 97%. 2014-94.9%, 2015-95.2%
- Continue to communicate all of the amazing activities taking place at our school to all stakeholders.
- Provide teachers with opportunities to peer mentor.
